

# SUMMER INTERNSHIP in TRANSPORTATION PLANNING

The Binghamton Metropolitan Transportation Study is a metropolitan planning organization, responsible for regional transportation planning for the Greater Binghamton Region. BMTS has a professional staff of planners and engineers housed by Broome County Government.

BMTS has one paid internship for summer 2009. The primary task of the intern will be the development of a GIS database of BC Transit bus stop accessibility, and related work. This will involve substantial field work for data collection as well as developing the GIS layer. The intern will work with the BMTS Transportation Analyst, who is responsible for GIS and the Binghamton Regional Travel Model.

Applicants should have basic knowledge of GIS, but should expect to learn and improve their knowledge of GIS. The intern will also have the opportunity to learn the fundamentals of transportation planning.

This is a full time position: 7.5 hours/day, 37.5 hours/week. The salary is \$9.00/hour.
