TRAFFIC COUNTER

The Binghamton Metropolitan Transportation Study is a metropolitan planning organization, responsible for regional transportation planning for the Greater Binghamton Region. BMTS has a professional staff of planners and engineers housed by Broome County Government.

BMTS has two Traffic Counter positions for summer 2009. This is a full-time temporary position for up to 14 weeks. Duties include substantial field work at intersections throughout the Binghamton metropolitan area, manually collecting vehicle turning movement counts during morning and afternoon peak periods, and related geometric and operational data about the intersection. The remainder of the day is spent at the BMTS Office downloading data and performing basic analyses. Employees have the opportunity to learn basic transportation engineering concepts.

The work day is 7½ hours. Because of the field schedule, there is free time in the middle of the day, which may be scheduled flexibly.

The position pays \$9.50/hour. Individuals must provide their own transportation to the count sites; mileage is reimbursed at the current IRS rate.
