- **2026-2030 TIP Amendment**  
[Resolution 2026-05, Approving an amendment to the 2026-2030 Transportation Improvement Program, PIN 904508, Rt. 201 Resurfacing, Flyover to Harry L Drive]

J. Yonkoski stated that as NYSDOT got closer to constructing the project, they had a clearer scope of the work that was needed. They are seeking an additional \$950,000 for concrete repairs that they were not originally anticipating. They are also adding \$1.3M

in additional funds for bridge work that would need to be done soon so it was decided to incorporate it into this project for efficiency.

A motion was made by R. Mack and seconded by L.Grubham; the motion passed unanimously.
